## South Lawrence Trafficway Public Comment Period Extended

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) are gathering public input on the South Lawrence Trafficway (SLT) Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) and the Identified Preferred Alternative. The agencies released the Draft SEIS for public review and began the public comment period on April 26, 2021. To allow the public additional time to review and comment on the Draft SEIS, the comment period end date is extended from June 21, 2021 to **September 30, 2021.** 

For the past three years, KDOT and FHWA have been evaluating the benefits and impacts of potential improvement options for the SLT. The purpose of the SEIS is to evaluate options for improving the SLT, including review of reasonable alternatives that will enhance safety and improve congestion while supporting its use as a thriving corridor for the City of Lawrence and the surrounding region.

The agencies hosted a public hearing featuring an in-person component on Wednesday, May 26, 2021 from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Baker University Wetland Discovery Center as well as a virtual component on Tuesday, May 25, 2021 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. A presentation was provided, and attendees had the opportunity to leave comments for the project team. More than 150 people attended the hearing and submitted 36 comments. A full summary of the questions and comments will be posted on the project website at the close of the Public Comment Period.

There are still multiple opportunities for participants to review the information and provide comments until September 30.
